

EDUKI 2021/2022 COMPETITION

LET'S GO SUSTAINABLE! Think global and act local

After the success of the previous years, the Eduki competition – under the high patronage of the Director General of the UN Geneva – is back for its **8th edition**, focusing on **3** of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs):

SDG 11 Make cities and human settlements inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable

SDG 12 Ensure sustainable consumption and production patterns

SDG 13 Take urgent action to combat climate change and its impacts

The competition invites students from all over Switzerland to explore and think about these **3 SDGs**, and to propose their best ideas for achieving them at local level.

All students aged 4 to 19, individually, in groups, by class or by school, can register with a teacher.

Registration opens on 1 September 2021

Children and young people can participate in the competition by submitting an **artwork**, a **media creation** or by conceiving a **concrete action** that can be implemented locally. The projects will be awarded at the **awards ceremony** on 4 May 2022 at the **Palais des Nations** in Geneva.

The aim of the competition is to raise the awareness of the students, question and reflect together on our lifestyles as well as our social, economic and ecological interactions with the world (around us):

- What behaviours can I promote to respond to the climate emergency?
- How much waste do I produce and how can I reduce it?
- How can I contribute to a caring and safe environment in my neighbourhood?

The competition aims to encourage students to take initiatives and imagine actions to make their daily lives more sustainable, because it is also through local actions that we contribute to the global!





Throughout the competition, the Eduki Foundation offers support to participants in the form of advice, material and resources for the preparation of their projects, information sessions for teachers and meetings between students and experts from international Geneva.

The cherry on top: projects in the «concrete action» category of Secondary II level can apply for the **Françoise Demole Award**, which supports the realisation and promotion of youth initiatives in the field of sustainable development and international cooperation with a total of 10,000 francs.
